Summit Meeting Review
3rd of march 2011

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OMPERDE

PROJECTS

Ralf & Gerlinde:

For Gerlinde Kaltenbrunner und Ralf Dujmovits the next project will probably again be the K2. Ralf:" Gerlinde will return to the K2 – this mountain is of magical attraction to her." She has not yet decided if she will affront her last still missing 8.000 m peak already this year or only in summer 2012 starting at the Chinese side (north route): The K2 is Gerlinde's mountain of fate which has already forced her six times over 8.000 m turning back and where her Swedish companion Frederik Ericsson fell to death before her eyes last year.

In case the ascent should succeed next time, it would be for her a very special summit meeting because then she will have conquered as 1st woman all 8.000 m peaks without artificial oxygen.



Hans Kammerlander:

At the moment Hans is mounting all Seven Second Summits (second-high summits of all continents), finishing them this year. He still has left 2 peaks, one in New Guinea and the other in the Antarctic.

His motivation:" the highest peaks of all continents are all too crowded. People on the bottom of the mountains are not so natural and original anymore. The second-highest mountains are often quite lonesome and you can experience people and everything around the mountains much better."



Huber Buam Alexander & Thomas:

Alex & Thomas don't give much away as usual, they prefer to surprise when time has come. As little information, they will go to the Arctic. There is a large island to the left of Greenland and a granite wall which will be a challenge for the "Huber Buam".





PROJECTS

Viki Groselj:

The SIR among the mountaineers is a superstar especially in Slovenia. He belongs to the 20 chosen Slovenian athletes who will represent one year of independency on the 20th independency day of the Slovenian Republic (24th June 2001):

From 15th – 17th April the sympathetic and very agile Viki will be acting on a stage together with Reinhold Messner. The piece "Invisible cities" written by Italo Calvino is put on stage by Matjaz Berger.

Later on he will be going to Nepal in order to collect film material for his TV-series "Giants of Himalaya" Apart of his teaching at a sports-elementary-school, since years he took to making films and writing books. He achieved already 11 books on Mount Everest and made multiple films. In June the premiere of his 9th film of the Himalaya series takes place — on the Cho Oyu 8.201m and in autumn starts the works for the 10th film on the Gasherbrum.

But previously (from 15th July to 30th August) he will be member of a TV Crew of a Slovenian expedition to the Nanga Parbat.

Davo Karnicar:

There was some talking that Davo plans to descend the K2 with skies. Personally asked, Davo told us that since 2 years he prepared himself with his friend and long-years companion Franz O. for this adventure. An ice avalanche led to bad luck and his companion died the 2nd day after the accident at an altitude of approx.6.500m. Davo suffered a trauma which made him decide to abandon this project for the moment. As father of 7 children he wants to live his live a little less dangerous. He does not plan further extreme projects, as he was very lucky up to now. He plans smaller projects in Siberia and north of Norway (SWALBAD). Furthermore he will be with a film crew in the Tatra (part of the mountain between Poland and Slovakia), also in Montenegro in order to promote remote and not so popular areas for tourism.



STATEMENTS of the ATHLETES on KOMPERDELL-Products

Hans Kammerlander: "Many people use the poles only when they already have problems, mainly with the knees and then it is too late. When using the poles right from the start there is of course much less strain, and the probability of severe injuries and wear is much less."





The guidance through the very interesting production line was done by Thomas Roiser personally.


Thomas Roiser in Interview: "An athlete is
